Hebrews 1

Highlight

"The Son is the Radiance of God's glory and the exact expression of his nature; Sustaining all things by his powerful Word. After making purification for sins, He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high." Heb 1:2-3

Explain

Jesus who is the Son is God arrived in flesh. He is the Radiance and the exact expression of the God of the Universe. He is the One who gave Himself for the Forgiveness of our sins. Then sat down at the right hand of the Father.

Apply

This passage is the Gospel. A God who loved us so much that He paid my debt. He took my place, took my punishment for our sins. He then conquered the grave. This is our message. This is more than enough.

Respond

Lord, may the gospel always stir my heart. May it always fill my heart with gratitude. May it always compel me to step out of my comfort zone and share it with others.

Highlight - [Hebrews 13:5]

Keep your life free from the love of money. Be satisfied with what you have, for he himself has said, "I will never leave you or abandon you."

Explain

The author has given a number of final instructions and like Paul commands that they not love money but instead be satisfied with what they've been given by their faithful Father. It is God's promise of presence that should bring satisfaction and security not money.

Apply

I am thankful to have God with me holding me secure. He will not leave me. I will be satisfied in him, not money.
I will be satisfied with the possessions I am given.

Respond

You choose what to give me. You are so generous and give us more than we need. Forgive me for wanting more than you have given. You are a God who stays with me. Teach our family how to be secure in your presence regardless of our amount of wealth.
