How to Finish Well...

1. INTENTIONALLY GIVE AWAY MY FAITH.

“O LORD, the God of the spirits of all living things, please appoint a new leader for the community. Give them someone who will lead them into battle, so the people of the LORD will not be like sheep without a shepherd.” Numbers 27:16-17 (NLT)

“...these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.” Deuteronomy 6:6b-7 (ESV)

2. INTENTIONALLY RUN TO THE FINISH.

“And there has not arisen a prophet since in Israel like Moses, whom the Lord knew face to face, none like him for all the signs and the wonders that the Lord sent him to do in the land of Egypt, to Pharaoh and to all his servants and to all his land, and for all the mighty power and all the great deeds of terror that Moses did in the sight of all Israel.” Deuteronomy 34:10-12 (ESV)

The Verdict on Moses

- **Moses knew God intimately.**
- **Moses allowed God to use Him.**
