Moses: The Power of a Selfless Life – Part 5

Exodus 33:7-11

1. A SPECIFIC PLACE.

“Now Moses used to take a tent and pitch it outside the camp some distance away, calling it the ‘Tent of Meeting.’ Anyone inquiring of the LORD would go to the Tent of Meeting outside the camp.” Exodus 33:7 (NIV)

Pillar: God met Moses.

*“Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart.”
Jeremiah 29:13-14 (NIV)*

2. A PLAN: INTENTIONAL WORSHIP.

A. The Word of God.

“For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.” Hebrews 4:12 (NIV)

B. Prayer.

“Inside the Tent of Meeting, the LORD would speak to Moses face to face, as a man speaks to his friend...” Exodus 33:11a (NLT)

C. Fasting.

“So he was there with the Lord forty days and forty nights. He neither ate bread nor drank water. And he wrote on the tablets the words of the covenant, the Ten Commandments.” Exodus 34:28 (NLT)

THE BOTTOM LINE: POWER FOR GOD’S PURPOSE.

“And the LORD replied, ‘I will personally go with you, Moses. I will give you rest—everything will be fine for you.’” Exodus 33:14 (NLT)
