WHAT DID JESUS ACCOMPLISH ON THE CROSS?

1. HE FULFILLED THE SCRIPTURE.

“Jesus said to them, ‘This is what I told you while I was still with you: Everything must be fulfilled that is written about Me in the Law of Moses, the Prophets, and the Psalms.’...He told them, ‘This is what is written: The Christ will suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, and repentance and forgiveness of sins will be preached in His name to all nations, beginning in Jerusalem.”

Luke 24:44-47 (NIV)

2. HE SATISFIED THE LAW.

“The law of Moses could not save us, because of our sinful nature. But God put into effect a different plan to save us. He sent His own Son in a human body like ours, except that ours is sinful. God destroyed sin’s control over us by giving His son as a sacrifice for our sins. He did this so that the requirements of the law would be fully accomplished for us...” Romans 8:3-4 (NLT)

“He canceled the record that contained the charges against us. He took it and destroyed it by nailing it to Christ’s cross.” Colossians 2:14 (NLT)

3. HE PAID MY PENALTY.

“God’s Son paid the price to free us, which means that our sins are forgiven.” Colossians 1:14 (GW)

“He sacrificed for their sins once for all when He offered Himself.” Hebrews 7:27 (NIV)

“Now that sins have been forgiven, there is no need to offer any more sacrifices.” Hebrews 10:18 (NLT)

4. HE CONQUERED SIN AND DEATH

“The sin of one man, Adam, caused death to rule over us. But all who received God’s wonderful, gracious gift of righteousness will live in triumph over sin and death through this one man, Jesus Christ.” Romans 5:17 (NLT)

“When Christ died, He died to defeat the power of sin one time—enough for all time.” Romans 6:10 (NCV)
