THE SEEDS OF CHARACTER I SOW NOW, WILL REAP A FUTURE HARVEST. (Judges 1:4- 8)

1. THE CERTAINTY.

"Don't be misled. Remember that you can't ignore God and get away with it. You will always reap what you sow!" Galatians 6:7 (NLT)

2. THE CONNECTIVITY.

"Then Adoni-Bezek said, 'Seventy kings with their thumbs and big toes cut off have picked up scraps under my table. Now God has paid me back for what I did to them.' They brought him back to Jerusalem and he died there."
Judges 1:7 (NIV)

3. THE CONFESSION.

"Those who live only to satisfy their own sinful desires will harvest the consequences of decay and death, but those who live to please the Spirit will harvest everlasting life from the Spirit. So don't get tired of doing what is good. Don't get discouraged and give up, for we will reap a harvest of blessing at the appropriate time." Galatians 6:8-9 (NLT)
